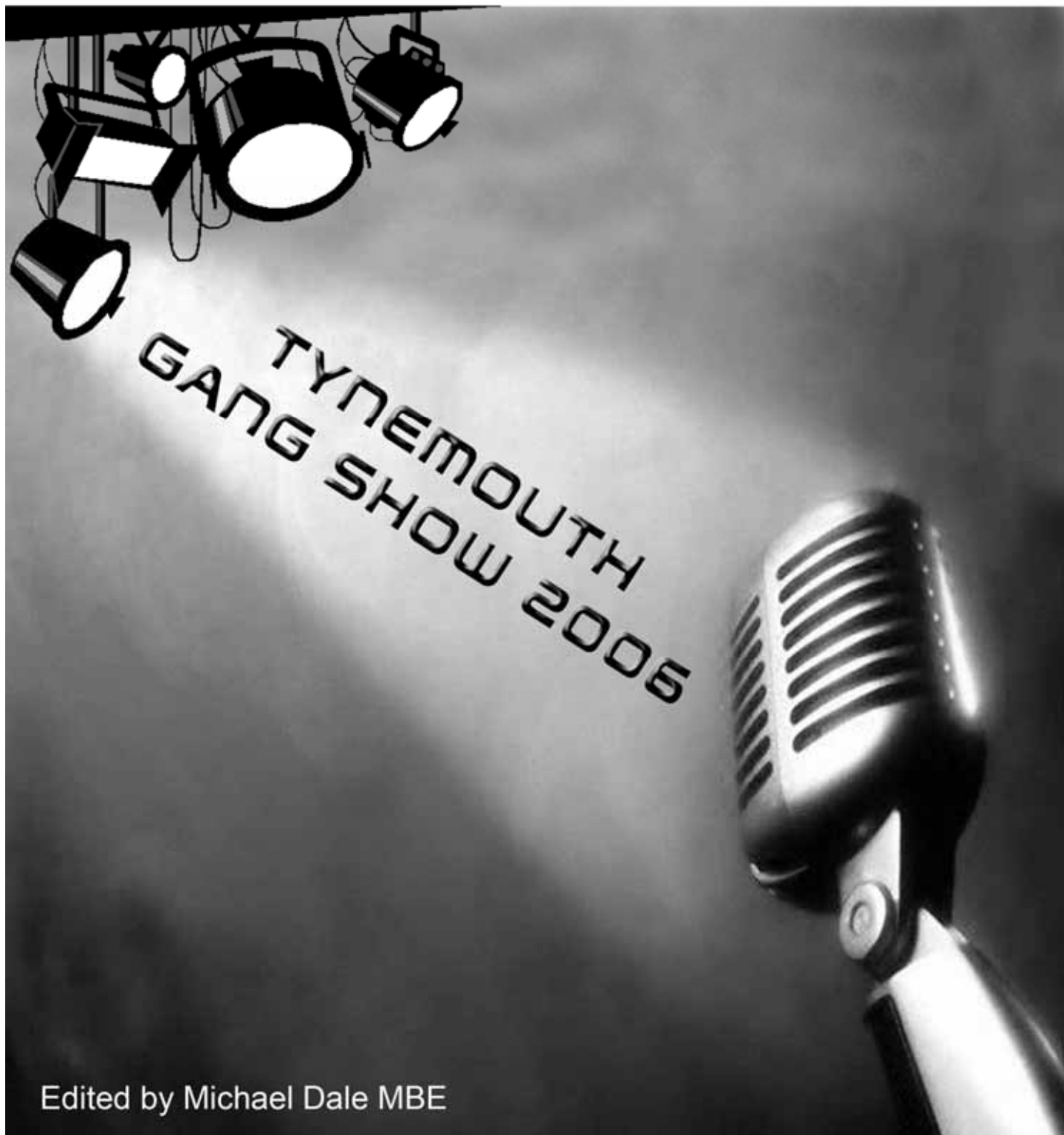

Did You Know?

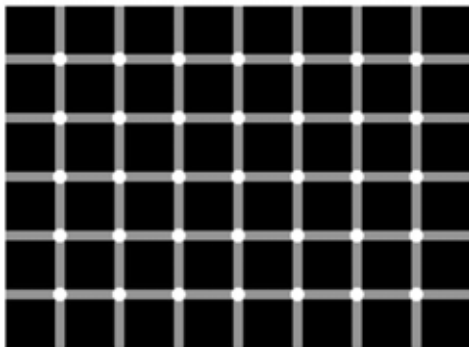
