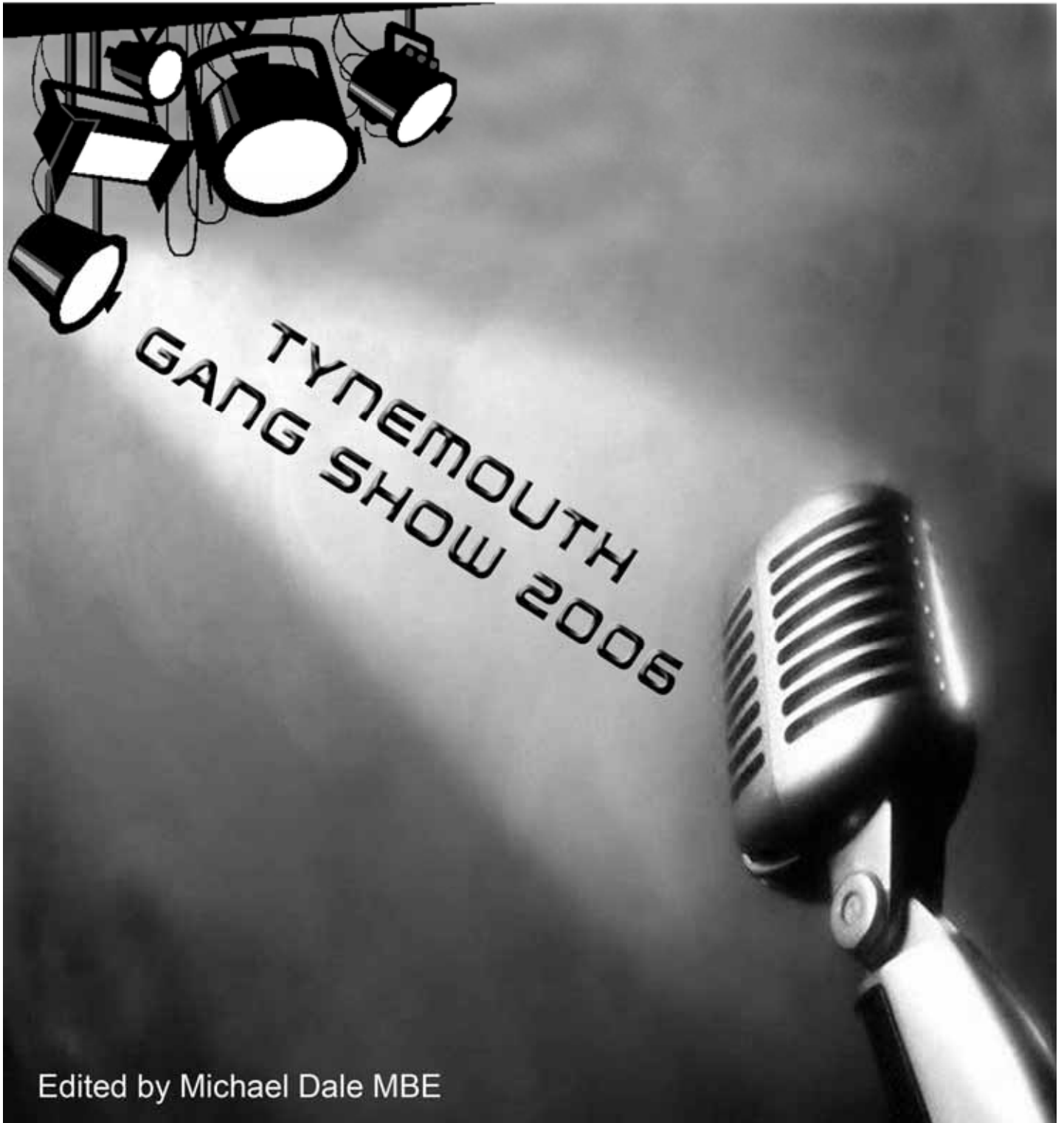

Female cast will also need a basket / creel or similar topped with flowers (either paper or artificial).
